Stain Disclaimer



Upon a client's request Sebago Furniture will stain or dye their furniture piece to a color sample that they have chosen at the time the piece is ordered. Whenever possible the preference is to use aniline dyes as they do not camouflage the beauty of the wood, other times it is necessary to use an oil-based wiping stain.

Once the customer has chosen a color sample, Sebago Furniture will supply two identical samples of a 2" x 3" stained or dyed wood sample of the material that your piece is to be made from. We ask that you sign and date each piece confirming your acceptance of the color. You will keep one piece and Sebago Furniture will keep the other for their records. It is important for you to know and understand that the sample you have chosen may differ slightly when the entire piece of furniture is stained or dyed with the exact same color. This variation is due to one of the following:

- 1. Large pieces will appear slightly different from the wood sample because the small sample does not necessarily show all of the grain pattern that a large piece may contain.
- 2. All woods absorb stains or dyes at different rates.
- 3. The natural base color of the wood may vary in color from the sample. Every effort will be made to match your chosen sample as closely as possible.

The customer must understand and agree to the above conditions of dying or staining commissioned pieces of furniture made by Sebago Furniture LLC.
